## **LCA AGREEMENT WITH Eulogia Christian School.**

Lighthouse Christian Academy, the distance-educational institution of Accelerated Christian Education (A.C.E. dba School of Tomorrow), offers a program designed especially for schools using the A.C.E. (hereinafter School of Tomorrow) curriculum.

Lighthouse Christian Academy is accredited through from Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools (MSA-CESS). All courses completed through LCA are fully accredited, which validates the quality of education provided to its students.

As a direct result of its accredited status, Lighthouse Christian Academy can validate the education students receive while attending other schools that have been approved to participate in the Dual Enrollment Program, including their compliance with LCA graduation requirements. Through the Dual Enrollment Program students may also receive the benefits of an accredited education.

## **Dual Enrollment Program:**

Lighthouse Christian Academy is offering each student attending on campus at a School of Tomorrow Model or Quality Status School the opportunity to receive **an accredited transcript and diploma** through participation in the LCA Dual Enrollment Program. Schools who have earned School of Tomorrow Model or Quality Status may begin this process by performing the following steps:

- Print and complete a Dual Enrollment Student Application for each student applying.
- Include the student's official transcript and annual dual enrollment fee.
- Send these documents to Lighthouse Christian Academy, postmarked or faxed by October 15.

## **Advantages:**

Transfer of Credits:

Accreditation eases the transition of students as they move from one accredited organization to another.

Access to Programs and Scholarships:

Accreditation aids students as they participate in sports programs, apply for federal grants, or pursue admission to accredited colleges.

## **Enrollment Deadline:**

For accreditation purposes, each student seeking to enroll in this program will need to apply at the beginning of each school year. This will allow LCA to validate and walk through the entire academic year with him. Student applications must be postmarked or faxed by October 15 each year.

## **Graduation Requirements:**

High school students are given a projected course of study based upon approved LCA graduation requirements, which will place them on the right track to graduate with an accredited LCA Diploma.

## **Language of Instruction:**

English

## **Dual Enrollment Graduation Policy:**

Students seeking to graduate through the LCA Dual Enrollment Program must meet the following requirements prior to receiving the diploma:

- Attend a Model or Quality Status School for at least the junior and senior years.

- Submit an application and current official transcript by October 15 of the student's senior year. The transcript will be thoroughly audited. Acceptance will be dependent upon the audit and whether the student will meet all academic standards required by LCA for graduation.
- Earn a minimum of six credit hours through LCA preceding graduation.
- Pay the graduation fee in addition to the Dual Enrollment Program fee.
- Complete all LCA graduation requirements as indicated on the LCA Academic Projection to the satisfaction of the administration.
- Fulfill all financial obligations.

**With this we also confirm that:**

1. Eulogia Christian School has complied with the Model/Quality Status requirements and thus is considered eligible for having its students admitted for the LCA Dual Enrollment program.
2. The Eulogia Christian School has the right to administer appropriate testing (current, quarterly and end of the year) to provide necessary records counting towards respective credits as listed in LCA graduation requirements.
3. LCA recognizes Eulogia Christian School students' results and accepts them for an appropriate validation process as established by LCA policies.
